

This half term (Spring 2), Year 4 will be learning about the following topics:

English	Writing This term we will be continuing with our topic 'The White Giraffe', Our topic is based on the book The White Giraffe written by Lauren St John. It is about a young girl who has moved from England to live with her Grandmother in South Africa. The children will be writing diary entries imagining that they are Martine the main character in the story. They will be learning about life in South Africa and how it is differs from life in England for Martine and we will be discussing Martine's feelings and expressing these through our writing. We will also be introducing the book 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell. The children will be writing character descriptions, instruction texts and adverts linked to this story. Spelling Punctuation and Grammar This term we will be focusing on using adjectives and adverbs and we will be continuing to learn how to use fronted adverbials in our work. We will be learning about past tense verbs and we will be encouraging the children to use speech in their writing. We will be continuing to have our daily spelling lessons and the children will be sent the spellings from each unit home every other week for them to learn. The words which Year 3 and 4 children are expected to be able to spell correctly are attached at the end of the newsletter for your information.
Maths	This term in Maths we will be continuing to practise using written methods for multiplication and division. Will will learn about decimal fractions such as tenths and hundredths. We will also learn about metric units of length, mass and capacity, as well as finding out how to measure the perimeter and area of a shape. We will practise interpreting bar charts and pictograms and answering questions about them. In geometry, we will learn about line symmetry, and how to compare angles.
Science	In Science, we will be learning all about Animals Including Humans . We will be studying how the digestive system works in humans and animals. We will be studying food chains and looking at the functions of different teeth and comparing them with different animals.

Topic (Geography)	We will be linking our Geography work to our topic 'The White Giraffe'. We will be looking at South Africa and carrying out Atlas work to see the different cities in South Africa in particular Cape Town. We will be looking at the different types of animals that may be found in the game reserve that is in our story. We will also be learning about a company who turn tea bags in to beautiful works of art and how they use the money made from their designs to support families living in nearby Imizamo Yethu township.
R.E.	This term in R.E. we will be looking at ' Believing '. The children will be discussing different people that they have in their life who help and support them. They will be thinking about what being happy means and what makes them happy and they will be exploring what the word inspiring means. We will be discussing what inspires them and how different things can inspire different people.

Art/D.T.	In Art the children will be making their own patchwork felt elephant. They will be working on their sewing skills. They will be creating their own cave paintings linked to our class story and the children will also be painting a scene from a South African game reserve.
P.E.	The children will continue to do gymnastics lessons on a Wednesday, exploring the topic of ' Balances '. We will be using the large apparatus this half term to perform our gymnastics skills. They will continue to do Games lessons and Street Dance on a Friday with the sports coaches. 4B will continue to go swimming on a Friday and any of 4A who have not achieved their 50m will also be swimming. Please ensure that all of the children have their trainers in school with their P.E. kit each week, as the weather is getting nicer we may have extra Games lessons outside.
French	In developing their oracy and literacy skills, the children will be learning new vocabulary in context, for example: the months of the year, adjectives that precede the noun and more verbs. They will also be using the vocabulary required to both ask and respond to more questions and to further develop sentence building through the use of sentence starters. We will continue to consider word classes with more punctuation and the definite article being introduced. Intercultural Understanding will be addressed through French Art and Music and through authentic French songs, stories and finger rhymes.
Homework	 The children's homework will go home on a Thursday and should be back in school for the following Thursday. English: Weekly comprehension homework and spellings or SPAG homework every other week. Maths: 1 piece of maths homework will be sent home each week. *Children should also be reading and practising their times tables every day and recording this in their planners.
