Information for Parents

Return to School Guidelines September 2020 Key Stage 2

General Guidelines:

These guidelines will be in place for at least September. They will be reviewed on our Inset on Wednesday 30th September.

- Pupils must wear their school uniform, but they can wear trainers as they will no longer be getting changed for P.E. .Instead, lessons will be done in uniform (remove tie and jumper), wearing trainers.
- No school bags/P.E. kits. In Key Stage 2, we will not be using the cloakroom areas to avoid bubbles mixing. Year 3, however, may use their cloakroom as only this year group bubble will be using this space.
- In KS 2, coats should be put on the back of pupils' chairs.
- All stationery/equipment will be provided for each pupil. Stationery must be named and stored in pupil's individual tray.
- Pupils may bring a named water bottle into school every morning. This
 cannot be refilled in school (unless it is exceptionally hot weather).
 Children must take their bottles home every evening to wash and refill.
- Pupils who have a packed lunch may continue to bring in their own packed lunch. These will be stored in the classroom.
- **Planners** these will not be sent home. Pupils will keep these in their trays until further notice.
- Home reading books these will not be sent home during September.
 Please encourage your child to read as much as possible at home and record on Seesaw, as they have been doing during Lockdown. E Books will be available for pupils to read at home via the Oxford Owl website.

 Your child's teacher will send username and password details to access this in September.
- Marking for September at the very least, marking will be minimal to avoid cross contamination. Wherever possible, teachers will mark work WITH the children. We will also continue to use Seesaw to provide feedback to pupils - e.g. when marking writing, teachers could give verbal feedback (V.F.) by recording a comment on Seesaw after pupil has taken a photo of their work.
- Homework no paper copies will be sent home. Instead, we will continue to use Seesaw to set homework and to monitor reading.

- SLT (wearing Hi- Viz vests) will supervise pupil entry onto school grounds by directing pupils to their specific entrance.
- T.A.s from each year group will help to direct pupils by their entrance points, wearing Hi-Viz vests.
- Pupils will line up in their classes, socially distancing as much as possible.
 Teachers will meet their class at the entrance point to take them into school.
- All pupils will wash/sanitise their hands when they enter school.

All year groups are classified as 'one bubble', so may mix at playtimes and lunchtimes on the same playground.

Each bubble must have their own playtime equipment in a box which must not be used by children from another bubble. Equipment must be wiped down by teacher/teaching assistant at the end of each day.

Lunchtimes
