We request all clothing to be **clearly labelled**. P.E. kits are kept in a P.E. bag on your child's peg.

Hairstyles

- Hairstyles should be neat and tidy
- Long hair should be tied up
- Partial hair colouring is discouraged
- Partial shaving, shaved lines, tram lines and the use of excessive quantities of hair product are not permitted.
- Headbands and any other accessories used to keep hair tidy/tied up should be small, neat and simple in design. They should be in the school colours, emerald green or navy blue.
- Hair extensions are not permitted.

Jewellery

Earrings and safety studs are not permitted. If ears are to be pierced this should be at the beginning of the summer holidays thereby allowing earrings and safety studs to be removed each day while at school.

For health and safety reason **we do not allow jewellery** to be worn in school, other than a watch. Watches must be simple and not be oversized or have any game or camera function.

Make up

No make-up is to be worn in school.

Nail Varnish is not permitted.

The only exceptions to these guidelines are when the dress code can be adapted because of religious or cultural beliefs, which should be registered at the office at the earliest opportunity.

Any child not in school uniform must have a note or phone call to school from a parent/carer to explain why.
