**At Davyhulme, 86% of pupils (60/70) achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics.**

**At Davyhulme, 19% of pupils (13/70) achieved the higher standard in reading, writing and mathematics .**

Provisional data from the DfE reports that **59%** of pupils nationally reached the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics.

**At Davyhulme, 80% of pupils (56/70) achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics .**

These include 3 pupils who did not sit the tests which significantly impacts average scaled score at D.P.S. 1 pupil - working below standard of test/ 1 pupil not registered due to long term sickness/1 pupil recently arrived from Ukraine and unable to access test.

The expected standard in the tests is a scaled score of 100 or above. The scaled score runs from 80 to 120 with 100 as the expected standard.

Provisional data from the DfE reports that **59%** of pupils nationally reached the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics (down from 65% in 2019).

**At Davyhulme, 77% of pupils (54/70) achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics .**
